

### The Yorktown Market Days 'Go Green & Garden' Market and Yorktown Riverwalk

The Farmer's Market opens at 8am and closes at Noon. It attracts vendors and shoppers from around the Yorktown area. **The YPA registration table and judging will be at the market on the York River side of Water Street.** It is a great place to capture people and vendors going about their day.

### Yorktown Victory Monument

The Yorktown Victory Monument commemorates the Battle of Yorktown. It stands at the end of Main Street and overlooks the battlefield and York River.

### Picnic area

The picnic area has tables with ramadas covering them and a view of the Coleman bridge. Move closer to the bridge and you have a view of the fishing pier.



### Moore House

The Moore house has been restored to appear as it had in 1781.



### Wormley Creek and Pond

Wormley Creek and pond are accessed by turning south from Ballard Street on the Historical Tour Trail. The trail is on the far South-East of the YPA boundary, is a one-way road and exits onto Cook Road.

### Yorktown National Cemetery

Established in 1866, there are 1,596 marked graves in the cemetery.



### Main Street

A short walk from the waterfront, Main Street has many houses appearing as they looked in the late 1700's. Some buildings have businesses and others are closed. The fronts of the houses are picturesque as well as the areas behind the houses. There are several parking areas close to Main Street. The Gallery at York Hall is on the Northwest side of Main Street with the Victory Monument at the other end.



### **American Revolutionary Museum**

This museum has indoor displays and an outdoor area that allow visitors to learn of and experience Colonial life. The outdoor area has a re-created Continental Army encampment and a Revolution-era farm.

**VERY IMPORTANT NOTE:** The Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation:

- Opens at 9AM.
- Is **waiving the entrance fee** for YPA participating artists – you must sign in at the front desk and show the name badge that you will receive when you register.
- For indoor areas - restricts artists to **dry media only**. Artists are not allowed to use paints indoors but are free to use their media of choice outdoors.
