"Join a Brush with History"

Welcome

Join us for Yorktown Plein Air Saturday April 11th, 2026! This event offers artists an opportunity to capture Historic Yorktown and share their talents with the local community. Located along the York River and rich in history, Historic Yorktown offers a wide range of subjects. The format for this event will allow artists several hours to create in the 2D media of their choice and submit it for judging.

Rules

This is a rain-or-shine event and is open to all 2D mediums except photography. Artwork will be judged and prizes awarded. Artists can register on line, by mail or in person. Mailed registration must include a signed registration form and a check or money order for \$30 and arrive before April 8th. If registering in person on the day of the event, bring a signed registration form and fee. The registration fee of \$30 is nonrefundable. Artists must -

- Check in with the Yorktown Arts Foundation table (located at the behind the Yorktown Market Days' Go Green & Garden Market along Water Street in the Riverwalk Landing area) at 8 a.m. or later. At check-in, you will receive registration information and have surfaces (canvas, paper, panels, etc.) stamped on the back. Surfaces must be blank with nothing pre-painted or pre-drawn on the surfaces.
- Submit artwork for judging at the Riverwalk Landing area no later than 11:45am. You must include a completed name/title/price label with your submission and supply an easel to display your work.
- Leave no trace while participating, disposing of trash and maintaining clean surroundings.
- Respect private property, asking permission of homeowners and businesses prior to setting up.
- Acknowledge that you cannot sell any artwork on York County or National Park Service property while participating in this event.
- Complete your painting within the event boundaries.
- Submit only original artwork that was created by the registered artist.

Timeline

8:00 a.m. or later – Artists check in at the Yorktown Arts Foundation booth at the Yorktown Market Days' Go Green & Garden Market table, have their surfaces (canvas, paper, panels, etc.) stamped and pick up their registration information. The artist must start with nothing pre-painted or pre-drawn on their surfaces.

8:00 a.m. to 11:45 p.m. – Artists capture Historic Yorktown.

Timeline - *continued*

11:45 p.m. – Artists return to the area designated for judging, place their artwork on their easel, and display their artwork for judging. Artwork must be framed or matted prior to display for ease of handling.

Noon - 1:00pm – Judging takes place and winners announced.

Recognition

The judge will recognize the efforts of the artists with a first, second, third and honorable mention awards. Participating artists will also be able to participate by voting and recognizing the artwork/artist with an 'Artists Choice' award.

Judge

Colonial National Historical Park Access

The National Park Service manages the battlefields, monuments and land surrounding Historic Yorktown. Artists painting within these areas will need a pass which is available for purchase from the Visitor Center and available online. Artists can purchase a pass for April 11th ahead of time. The Standard Pass is \$15 with discounts for seniors and military.

Yorktown Market Days' Go Green & Garden Market

The **Yorktown Plein Air** event coincides with the Yorktown Market Days' Go Green & Garden Market. Yorktown Market Days is held weekly along the York River where vendors, local artists, and food trucks attract shoppers to buy seasonal produce, seafood, meats, breads, soaps, candles, honey, gourmet dog treats, and more! NOTE to artists - The market moves to the covered Water Street Parking Terrace during inclement weather.
