

Information for artists submitting works to the Sixth Annual Veterans Art Show

The Yorktown Arts Foundation and the On the Hill Gallery are showcasing artwork of those who are serving or who have served in the military.

- Dates of the event: November 4 – 22, 2024
- Categories are two dimensional art, three dimensional art and photography.
- The show is open to all media.
- Submissions must be ready to hang or display. Saw tooth hangers are not allowed. Maximum size on one side for photography and 2D art is 30”.
- Limited to two submissions per artist.
- Submissions must be appropriate for public display.
- There is no entry fee.
- Artists do not need to be members of the YAF to participate.
- Entries must have a completed submission form and include the name and contact information of the artist, name of the piece, primary media and purchase price or labeled NFS. Include the form when dropping off your art.
- The gallery retains a commission of 35% on all sales. Applicable state sales tax will be collected from purchaser.
- Drop off date is **Saturday Nov 2nd or Sunday the 3rd between the hours of 1:00 - 4:00 pm** at the Yorktown Public Library at 8500 George Washington Memorial Highway, Yorktown, VA. Artists may arrange to drop off before the 2nd but art will not be accepted after the 3rd.
- By submitting artwork, the artist is agreeing to have the artwork included in exhibition promotional material, unless otherwise stated by the artist.
- A reception will be held on November 9th from 5:00-6:30pm welcoming the artists, their friends and family as well as the public. Refreshments will be served and awards for 1st, 2nd 3rd and honorable mention will be announced at the reception. Artists are limited to winning one award if they enter in more than one category.
- The show ends Nov 22th. Artists can pick up their pieces Nov 23th or the 24th from 1-4pm at the library or make arrangements with On the Hill gallery.
